- Monitor your attendance and seek explanations for any absences
- Provide pastoral help and support to ensure you make the most of your time here.

As a student, you are expected to:

- Be respectful of fellow students, staff and the school environment
- Respect others' right to learn & to study and never to adversely affect the education of others
- Attend all Assemblies, Tutor Registration times and lectures/talks as requested
- Arrive at all timetabled lessons punctually, prepared to work
- Use supervised study periods to complete coursework, homework and revision as directed
- Conform to the rules set out in the school Library and The Cube study areas
- Involve yourself with 'sixth form life' from an extra-curricular perspective
