This agreement outlines the school's expectations of parents and students and sets out what we do as a school to ensure that all students are given the best possible chance of a good all-round education, an enjoyable time in a large, diverse school and an understanding of community.

The school will make every effort to:

- promote the best possible learning atmosphere for everyone;
- record attendance and inform you of any irregularities and address any concerns;
- enforce school rules;
- apply the regulations concerning school uniform and dress code;
- provide you with regular information on your child's progress and invite you to the school to talk with their teachers;
- deliver a range of strategies to support learning, enable students to catch up and prepare for exams;
- invite you to discuss matters of concern.

As parent(s) I/we will make every effort to:

- ensure my child attends school regularly, on time and properly equipped;
- support the school's policy on school uniform and behaviour;
- inform the school on the first day that my child is going to be absent for any reason and follow this up with a written explanation, supported by medical evidence, if required;
- create appropriate conditions for my child to do their homework and ensure that the work is done;
- keep in contact with the school regarding progress and behaviour, attend parents' evenings and visit the school if requested;
- ensure holidays are not taken during term time;
- to contact the school directly to raise any concerns;
- ensure that all communication about the school on social media is through the school's official social media domains, is informative and supportive of the school at all times.
- to support the school's strategies to help my child progress and prepare for exams.

As a student of Great Baddow High School I will make every effort to:

- attend school regularly and on time;
- bring all appropriate equipment for the day;
- comply with the school rules;
- wear the correct uniform and present myself tidily at all times;
- do my classwork and homework to the best of my ability;
- be polite and respect my peers, staff and all other members of the school and wider community;
- respect school property and equipment;
- keep the school free from litter and graffiti;
